**General Criteria:**

- ✓ Applicant must be formally admitted to the School of Education undergraduate/graduate program and have an overall GPA of 3.0
- ✓ Applicant must submit an essay in response to a selected piece of poetry preferably by Robert Frost.

**Essay Criteria:**

Essay should be a response to a selected piece of poetry, preferably by Robert Lee Frost. The typed essay should be double spaced, one inch margins, 12 point font.

The scholarship is renewable provided the recipient remain in the School of Education program and continue to maintain a grade point average of at least 3.0 and meet all other University academic requirements. **Applications are due by February 1, 2013.**
