Mr. Krystofiak has served on the faculty of the Music Department at University of St. Thomas since 1986 and maintains a private piano studio.



He holds graduate degrees in piano performance and piano pedagogy from the University of Houston and has performed and studied in Europe. Among his teachers are Abbey Simon, Ruth Laredo, and Andrzej Dutkiewicz of the Warsaw Conservatory.

He served six terms as President of the Houston Music Teachers Association (HMTA). He was named outstanding alumnus in 1990 by his alma mater in Wisconsin. In 1993 he was honored by HMTA with the Teacher of the Year award and Service award. He was nominated to the Executive Board of the Texas Music Teachers Association.
