BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Professor, researcher, scholar, historian, author, poet, traveler, amateur chef, ex-naval officer, refurbisher, swimmer, tennis player – a composite of the person Lou Swilley. (borrowed from an article in <u>The Cauldron</u>, April 5, 1977, page 5)

Swilley was born in Houston, Texas, on December 5, 1929. His education included Annunciation Catholic School (1935-43), St. Thomas High School (1943-47), University of St. Thomas (1947-51 – the first graduating class of the school), Catholic University of America (1951-52), Rice University (1956-59), University of Houston (1960-61 – Master of Art in English). He served in the Navy as an officer from 1952 -56.

While at the University of St. Thomas, he was a student worker in the library. This carried over into the years after graduation and opened the door for a career in the field of teaching. He substituted for a former UST English professor, Fr. Edward Lee, who had become ill. As a result of this experience, teaching became his passion for 37 years – 20 years at UST and 17 years at St. Thomas High School. The year 1966 found him in England at the London Film School on a year-long sabbatical leave. In 1957, he joined the UST faculty as a professor in the English Department, subsequently becoming chair of that department (1971-77). He further served on the Library Committee and the Curriculum Committee. Louis had the ability to see beyond the classroom at the

University; he was quick to offer suggestions for improvements in various areas of the school. Evidence of this, and his dedication to the school, can be found in letters to members of the administration about those issues. Swilley retired from his faculty responsibilities in 1977. In the meantime, he became a member of the faculty of the English Department at St. Thomas High School until 1990.

Swilley's interest in the teaching profession continued until his death, writing prolifically on various aspects of the profession. He was a constant poster on the internet education sites, offering opinions and suggestions on schools and teaching, which eventually led to his producing "A Teachers' Catechism."

Further writings included two novels, 'Inferno' of the Future. A Tale of the 23rd Century and Hearts. Heart of Darkness in a Modern Ghetto; two plays; 2 children's stories; My Teaching Years at St. Thomas High School. Essays and Poems on Various Subjects. 1972-1990, Edward Gregory Lee, C.S.B. Articles, Course Notes and Letters. He was an avid reader, Ulysses by James Joyce being a favorite, and an expert on Shakespearean literature, which involved regular visits to England.

Louis Swilley died February 14, 2011, in a local Houston hospital.
