GUIDELINES FOR AFFIDAVIT

Applicants who wish to be considered for in-state financial aid based on Section 2 of House Bill 1403 must meet <u>all</u> of the following criteria <u>and</u> submit the Affidavit of Intent to Become a Permanent Resident:

The applicant must have graduated from a Texas high school or have received a GED in Texas; or will do so before actually enrolling at the University of St. Thomas.

and

The applicant must have resided in Texas for at least 3 consecutive years as of the date of graduation from high school or receipt of GED.

and

The applicant must have lived with a parent, guardian or conservator while attending a public or private high school in Texas.

and

The applicant must **not** have enrolled in any college/university courses <u>or</u> received college credits prior to the Fall 2001 semester.
