Rotary International seeks young professionals for cultural exchange team to Korea

September 21, 2007 – Are you a young professional with a desire to experience the culture and people of Korea? Would you like to spend an expense-free month in Korea meeting and living with influential Korean business representatives and dignitaries?

The Greater Houston area Rotary District 5890 (www.rotary5890.org) is seeking applicants to be members of a Group Study Exchange (GSE) team that will be traveling to Rotary District 3670 in Korea from April 11 to May 11, 2008. The team will consist of four young professionals from various vocational backgrounds and will be led by a District 5890 Rotarian. All GSE team members' expenses (travel, accommodation and meals) will be paid for by Rotary International. The GSE team will reside and board with Korean Rotarians and their families during the exchange trip.

“We are delighted to be able to offer this chance-of-a-lifetime experience to Houston young adults,” said Mike Dennard, Rotary District 5890 GSE co-coordinator. “Having the opportunity to become close friends with Korean professionals, to stay in their homes and live with their families is a rare and exciting prospect. Most GSE team members will find that the Korean people they meet during this experience will provide them with a new network for lifelong friendships and business relationships. Please note, we seek to inform prospective team members' employers of the benefits of the GSE program so that GSE team members can take a month from their profession and participate in this valuable exchange program.”

To be eligible, applicants must be between the ages of 25 and 40, currently employed, have clearance to take time from their profession, have time to participate in the preparation and language training activities, reside in District 5890, be a U.S. citizen, and be physically and mentally prepared for the rigorous GSE itinerary and travel schedule. Also note, applicants may NOT be direct relatives of Rotarians.

The GSE team will have a varied travel itinerary that will include cultural and historical visits, participation in Korean Rotary activities and meetings with Korean professionals who share the GSE team member's vocation. The GSE team members will make several team presentations to host Korean Rotary Clubs describing facts about Houston and their personal life in Texas. Upon return, GSE team members will be invited to share their experiences at Rotary Clubs and other community organizations.

You will be required to participate in a reception for applicants (by yourself, please) at 7 p.m. on Friday, 2 November. Your interview will be conducted during the day on Saturday, November 3.
