



Graduate PLUS Loan

As part of your financial aid package, you have been awarded a Federal PLUS Loan. The University of St. Thomas has an exciting new web-based service for you to use in applying for this loan. This web-based system will simplify the process for you and for us.

To initiate this process, please follow the instructions below:

1. Navigate to TG Loans by Web™ at <https://lbw.tgslc.org>
2. Logon to myTG or click 'New User' and register for a myTG account.
3. Once you have logged on, select your borrower type — **Graduate Student Borrower**
4. Enter your Social Security Number and date of birth and click on login.
5. Select **Complete Loan Award** from the main menu.
6. Under Option 2, choose the University of St. Thomas from the drop-down list and select **Create Loan Request**.
7. Complete **Loan Entrance Counseling** and receive a confirmation.
8. **Return to TG Loans by Web™** and continue the application process and provide all necessary information.
9. Enter reference information, including the addresses and phone numbers of two references.
10. Select a lender from the sample list** provided or search for your lender.
For faster service, choose the **E-Sign*** button at the bottom of the final page.
*If you are not able to e-sign, you will need to print the application and mail it directly to your lender. If this is not done, your application will NOT be reviewed.
11. Review and submit your loan award information.
(Click **Back** at the bottom of the screen to make changes.)
12. Your lender will obtain credit approval. To retrieve the results of your credit request, simply click on **Online Credit Status**.
13. Logout of Loans by Web™, and you are done!
