DUAL CREDIT COURSES IN SUMMER & FALL

Students who are entering their junior or senior year of high school in 2013 can apply for courses to earn Dual Credit in both high school and college. University of St. Thomas has a list of approved courses online at the website www.stthom.edu/summer.

- Admission criteria based on PSAT/SAT/ACT scores.
- A GPA of 3.0 on high school coursework with official transcript from high school is required.
- Students wanting to enroll in a course with a prerequisite must satisfactorily complete that prerequisite before they are allowed to register.
- Homeschoolers with standardized test scores are welcomed.

MENDENHALL SUMMER INSTITUTE

Incoming UST college freshmen can apply for the Mendenhall Summer Institute. Students can get ahead this summer with six credit hours of English, math or science.

- The Mendenhall Summer Institute is a five-week program for a selected group of incoming freshmen with proven academic skills and involvement in extracurricular activities.
- The Mendenhall Summer Institute will meet Monday-Thursday from July 8 - Aug. 8. Classes are 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and cost \$750. Textbooks, fees and optional meal plans are additional costs.
- Living on campus is an option that helps prepare for daily assignments and work collaboratively with your classmates.
- Upon successful completion of the Summer Institute, you may be considered for an annual Mendenhall grant valued at \$2,000 per year for four years. The award is based on financial need, academic performance and involvement in the program.

SUMMER INSTITUTE OF MATHEMATICS (UST-SIM)

The University of St. Thomas Summer Institute of Mathematics (UST-SIM) is a one-week program open to 20 students. It is designed to enrich and build upon concepts learned in algebra and geometry. The critical thinking skills of students will be further developed through solving problems, applications and a project. Concepts presented during the program will also introduce students to the art of mathematical thinking.

All students who are accepted to the program should be familiar with concepts from Algebra I and Geometry. Students should know how to solve equations, triangle relations, and how to find areas and volumes.

D.R.E.M.E. @ UST SCIENCE SUMMER CAMP

University of St. Thomas, in collaboration with the Dr. Ronald E. McNair Educational Science Literacy Foundation will host the D.R.E.M.E. @ UST Science Summer Camp again this summer. High school students from the greater Houston area are invited to apply.

The camp will engage students by letting them conduct science. All activities are hands-on, and students will have the opportunities to conduct experiments and learn for themselves. Participants will gain a feel for a college setting and also the types of work they can do with a science career.

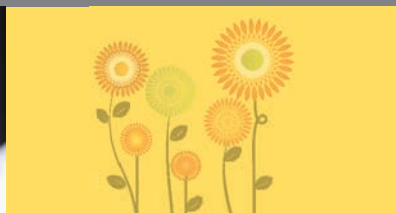

MUSIC PREPARATORY SCHOOL SUMMER CAMPS

Houston Piano Day Camp & Anniversary Gala Extravaganza, June 17 - 21, 2013

- Group and individual piano instruction.
- Hands-on experience with the harpsichord, clavichord and organ.

Summer Guitar Camp, July 8 - 12, 2013

- Summer Guitar Camp is a program designed for aspiring musicians to promote the growth and development of musical knowledge and skills.
- The program caters instruction to the student's personal style, level of experience and musical goals.
- Students learn in a healthy, noncompetitive and supportive environment.
- Complete immersion in music allows students to walk away with many material and musical ideas
- Whether students have just begun playing guitar and want to get started in the right direction, or have been playing professionally and want to further develop their craft, students will find what they are looking for at the Summer Guitar Camp.

String Institute, July 15 - 19, 2013

Advanced string players will rehearse and perform electrifying concertos for the string orchestra by the great Venetian composer, Antonio Vivaldi.

Students will have the opportunity to:

- View and discuss manuscripts and first editions.
- Learn about Venetian culture and history.
- Be exposed to the work of Vivaldi's contemporaries and to learn about his music's enormous influence on Johann Sebastian Bach.

The repertory will consist of pieces from the Concerto Grosso genre, including concertos that feature multiple violin and cello soloists, such as the extraordinary concerto in G-minor for two cellos. One violin student will be chosen to perform a concerto from the "Four Seasons."

Chamber Ensemble Workshop, July 15 - 19, 2013

Select students will be put into level-appropriate ensembles of three to five to perform masterpieces of the chamber repertoire.

Students will have the opportunity to:

- Rehearse with members of the Axiom Quartet and guest coaches.
- Learn detailed concepts and techniques of chamber music playing.
- Play a public concert in Cullen Recital Hall.

The Chamber Music Workshop may be taken by itself or in conjunction with the String Institute.

Math & Music Academy, July 22 - 26, 2013

The Math & Music Academy offers a unique opportunity for students to enhance their understanding of mathematical and musical concepts through the examination of the interconnection between math and music.

Students will have the opportunity to:

- Examine the mathematics of beats.
- Visualize tones.
- Explore the mathematical differences in musical intervals.

Private/Individual Lessons

Students can take lessons in piano, guitar, voice, orchestral instruments and composition. Student-teacher Instruction is available in 30-minute, 45-minute and 60-minute sessions. Contact the Music Preparatory School for cost.

VOLLEYBALL CAMPS

All Skills Camp

Dates:	June 17 - 19, 2013
Registration:	June 17 at 8 a.m.
Hours:	9 a.m. - 5 p.m., daily
Grades:	5 -12
Cost:	\$225 (lunch included)

Players can maximize their volleyball potential at the All Skills Camp. If a player's goals are to improve their overall technique, general tactical knowledge and play collegiate volleyball, this is the camp for them. All skills will be taught and reviewed including serving, passing, setting, hitting, blocking and digging. It is a rigorous and challenging program with first-rate competition and outstanding instruction.

Team Camp

Dates:	July 22 - 25, 2013
Hours:	July 22, two-hour practice with UST staff during the day July 23 - 25, 1 p.m. - 7 p.m., competition
Grades:	Freshman, junior varsity and varsity teams
Cost:	\$100 per player, minimum of seven players per team

Team Camp is an intense, structured program that will focus on team development and performance through training with high school teammates and competition against participating camp teams. Each team will receive a two-hour practice with UST staff and the remainder is competition and play. Team Camp will allow coaches to try different lineups before the high school season of competition begins.

Satellite Camp

Bring the UST volleyball program to your school! UST volleyball staff will work with your school to design a camp that specifically targets all areas of the game that needs to be improved at your school. Camp days are typically five hours with two sessions per day. Sessions range in content to include individual skill development, team training, position work, conditioning and team building. UST staff can also assist with pre-game warm-ups and season practice planning.

Satellite Camps mix and match different sessions to maximize the value for an individual program.

Contact the UST volleyball staff in advance to reserve dates as slots fill up quickly. Dates are available throughout June and July.

- Four-hour days, 12 player minimum
- Two Day - Four Session Camp: \$100 per camper
- Three Day - Six Session Camp: \$150 per camper
- Four Day - Eight Session Camp: \$180 per camper
