APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION CHECKLIST

Required materials for:

ALL DEGREE-SEEKING APPLICANTS:

- A completed application for admission (application for admission also serves as scholarship application).
- A non-refundable \$25 application fee (not required if applicant has a College Board Fee Waiver).

Additional materials required for:

ALL FRESHMAN APPLICANTS

- Test scores from either the SAT or ACT.
(UST school code for SAT is 6880, and 4238 for ACT.)
- Official high school transcript, homeschool transcript, or official copy of GED mailed directly to the Office of Admissions.
- If enrolled in dual-credit courses with a college/university, must submit an official college transcript.

TRANSFER APPLICANTS

- An official transcript from every college/university attended.
- For transfer applicants with fewer than 24 semester hours of earned college credit, an official high school transcript will also be required.
- For transfer applicants with fewer than 24 semester hours of earned college credit, scores from either the SAT or ACT if applicant has graduated from high school within the past 5 years.

It is strongly encouraged that, as a part of the application process, students fill out the FAFSA at www.fafsa.ed.gov.

INTERNATIONAL APPLICANTS:

- In lieu of SAT/ACT scores, official TOEFL scores (or completion of Level 112 through ELS Language Center) may be submitted if first language is not English. Minimum score is 213. UST school TOEFL code is 6880. SAT/ACT scores are strongly encouraged for scholarship consideration.
- Most foreign high school and college transcripts require translation and evaluation by an independent service accredited by the National Council on the Evaluation of Foreign Student Credentials (CEC).
- Additional forms required by U.S. Immigration and Naturalization Service available through the Admissions Office.

ALL NON-DEGREE-SEEKING STUDENTS:

- A completed application for admission.
- A non-refundable \$25 application fee.
- Visiting students must submit a transcript from last college attended or verification of good academic standing from home institution.
- Post-baccalaureate students must submit official transcripts from degree-granting institutions.
