Students are required to purchase a meal plan. Options include Celts Market Place and Quizno's inside Crooker Center. Celts Market Place serves breakfast, lunch, and dinner Monday through Friday, brunch on Saturday and brunch and dinner on Sunday. Quizno's is open seven days a week.

Celts Market Place offers many choices including low-fat, low-carb, and vegetarian meal options. A salad and soup bar, sandwich station, fresh vegetables, hamburgers, pizza, baked goods and desserts are offered at all afternoon and evening meals. Quizno's offers sandwiches, flatbread salads and soups.

Campus Living

Living on the University of St. Thomas campus provides students with convenience, affordability, safety and greater access to University activities. Studies have shown that students who choose to live on campus have better grades, are more involved in the campus community and can transition more easily into the University culture.

The University has two types of campus housing to meet each individual student's needs:

- Guinan Residence Hall under the direction of Residence Life is a three-story, 306-bed facility with private double-occupancy rooms
- Young Hall is also encompassed in Residence Life and offers apartments to upper-class students and graduate or adult students who want to benefit from a Residence Life community

Guinan Residence Hall and Young Hall offer in-residence programs and activities designed specifically for residential students. These events are both fun and educational, and will help you build friendships and establish a community of your own.



Guinan Residence Hall

Guinan Residence Hall, located near the Moran Parking Center and Crooker Center, provides a residential experience focused on community living, yet offers plenty of quiet space when wanted.

Features of Guinan Residence Hall include:

- Double-occupancy rooms with private bathrooms and individually-controlled thermostats
- Furnished rooms with extra-long, twin-size beds, two desks, two chairs, and two dressers
- Rooms are equipped with MicroFridges (refrigerator with freezer and microwave oven), two Internet connections and one cable television connection with access to 64 channels
- A computer lab, located on the second floor, is equipped with up-to-date software. Wireless Internet access is also available in the lobby atrium.
- On-site laundry room

Young Hall

Young Hall, located on the south side of campus, offers apartments to upper-class, graduate or adult students who want to benefit from a Residence Life community. All apartment residents are required to have a roommate.

Features of Young Hall include:

- Choice of one, two or three bedroom units
- Full-service kitchens with appliances
- Furnished bedrooms with two extra-long twin-size beds, two chairs, two dressers and two desks. Furnished living room with one sofa and two end tables. Furnished dining room with a dining room table and chairs.
- Resident assistant staff, maintenance staff, on-site laundry and center courtyard
