- ✓ The Robert Lee Frost Scholarship in Secondary Education assists students in the School of Education interested in teaching English at the middle school or high school level.
- ✓ This scholarship may be awarded to continuing or transfer undergraduate or graduate students with preference given to undergraduate students.
- ✓ Applicant must be formally admitted to the School of Education undergraduate/graduate program and have an overall GPA of 3.0.
- ✓ Applicant must submit an essay in response to a selected piece of poetry preferably by Robert Frost. The essay should exhibit rich imagery, and describe how the piece of poetry influenced the student's life. The typed essay should be double spaced, one inch margins, Times New Roman, and 12 size fonts.
- ✓ The scholarship is renewable provided the recipient remain in the School of Education program and continue to maintain a grade point average of at least 3.0 and meet all other University academic requirements.
