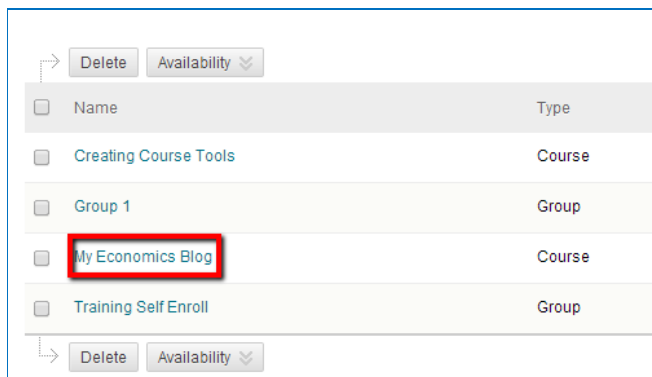


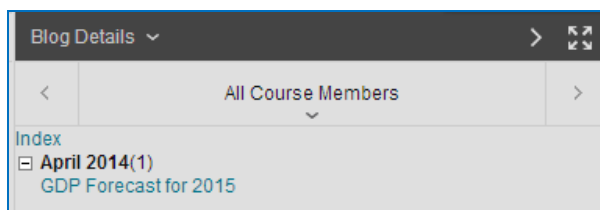
Commenting on a Blog Post

To add a comment to an existing Blog entry, whether your own or someone else's:

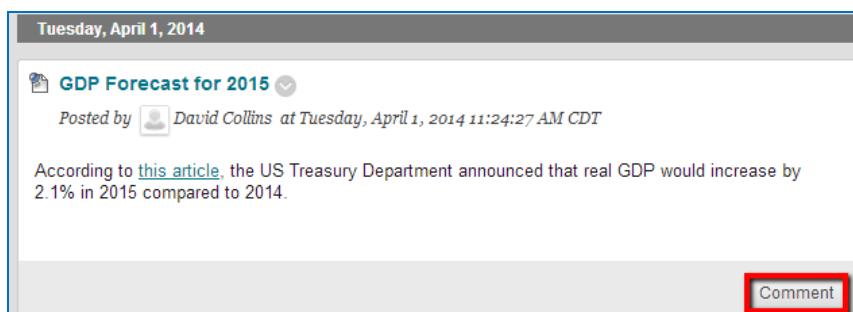
1. Open a blog.




2. Click the link in the Index for the week or month of the appropriate blog post.



3. Click the **Comment** button for the post.




4. Enter a comment in the Comment field. Click the spell check button at the bottom-right if necessary.




