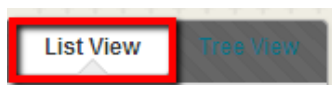



Changing Which Threads Display in a Forum

If you have many threads in a forum and assign different statuses to the threads, you can choose which threads you wish to see in a forum. For example, if you start several threads and save them as drafts, you can choose to show only those drafts and select the threads to edit and publish. This has no effect on what other users see in the forum; however, the Display filter remains in effect even after you log out and back into Blackboard.

1. Access the forum and change to **List View**, if needed.



2. On the action bar, point to **Display** to access the drop-down list, and select the type of threads to view in the forum.
