

- To sort a column, click the column heading or caret. For example, if you sort the Forum column, the items appear in alphabetical or reverse alphabetical order.
- To view the threads in a forum, click the forum's title. Forums containing unread posts appear in bold type.
- For each forum, view the total number of posts, the number of unread posts, and the number of users who have participated in the forum. For one-click access to the forum's unread messages, click the link in the Unread Posts column.

By default, the Search pane is hidden to save screen space. Click **Search** to display the search pane, which allows you execute keyword searches on any forum, and before or after a specified date and time. You cannot specify a date in the future as the "Before" date. When you have all your criteria in place, click the **Go** button.
