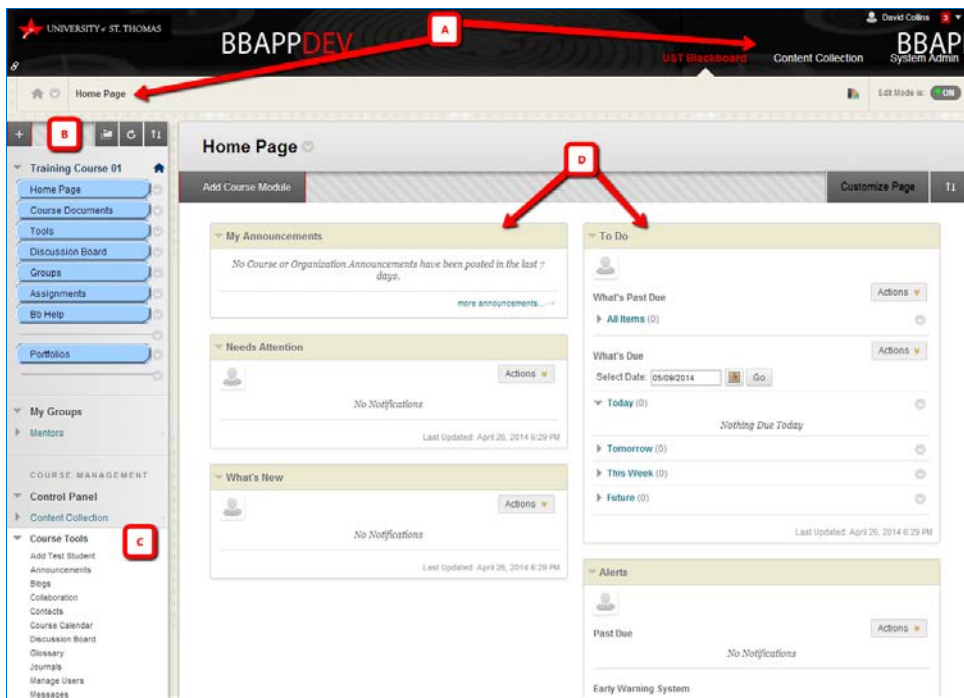


Blackboard Course Home Page Interface

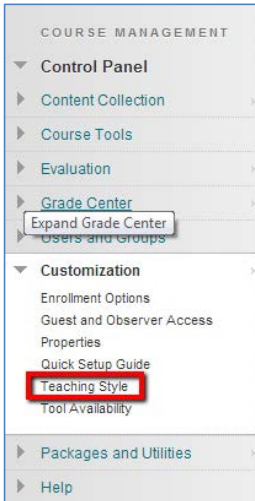
Click the title of any course in the My Courses module of the Dashboard (or in Global Navigation) to display that course's Home Page.



- A. The top pane features navigational links just as on the main dashboard.
- B. The Course Menu allows you to add links to content within the course and to external websites. Students will see the Course Menu as well, but you can keep some links hidden from them as needed.
- C. The Course Management section is specifically for Instructors. It features the Control Panel, with quick links to dozens of tools for designing and building the course and its contents.

- D. Modules give you quick access to important information such as due dates and assignments that need to be graded. You can add, remove, and reposition modules for your convenience.

The Course Home Page appears by default. In order to change that, under the Control Panel on the left pane, click **Customization** and then **Teaching Style**. Select a new Entry Point for the course, and click **Submit**. (See the tutorial on the Control Panel for more information.)



Also by default, Blackboard courses will have a **Home Page** link near the top of the Course Menu. Even if you remove that link, you will find links to the course's home page above and at the top of the Course Menu.
