#### **Historical Note**

Rev. Vincent J. Guinan, CSB, served as the first president of the University of St. Thomas and dedicated himself to raising scholarships to assist capable young people who otherwise might not be able to receive a liberal arts education in a Catholic co-educational University. Scholarships were awarded to students on the basis of scholastic excellence and financial need. The student had to be of good character, show initiative, sociability and must merit the approval of the Scholarship Board.

In 1975 Rev. Francis E. Monaghan, CSB, served as UST's vice president of scholarships and was actively involved in university fundraising efforts, including the annual Mardi Gras gala. Before becoming vice president of scholarships, he was a lecturer in music education, university treasurer, vice president for community services, and chairman of the scholarship committee. He also served on the Board of Directors.

The St. Thomas Memorial Scholarship Association was established in 1948 for the purpose of giving a living memorial to St. Thomas High School students who had died in the service of their country. The Association sponsors twelve Masses each year for the St. Thomas war dead.

#### **Biographical Note**

Francis E. Monaghan, CSB was associated with the University of St. Thomas and the Houston community for over 40 years. He was a well-loved and highly regarded member of the UST community. His special interest was the scholarship program. In honor of his many years of dedicated service, in 1992, the University named the General Scholarship Fund the Fr. Francis E. Monaghan Scholarship Fund. Contributions to this fund continue to be solicited in Fr. Monaghan's memory. He passed away on April 7, 1995. Although gifts of any amount are appreciated, a total gift of \$125,000 is required to establish one full scholarship. The goal is to award 22 full tuition scholarships to UST students each year. To accomplish this goal, an endowment of \$2 million is required.
