### **University of St. Thomas Custom Itinerary**

- July 20<sup>th</sup>, 2016 Depart Houston
- July 21<sup>st</sup> Arrive in Rome. Pray at S. Pietro in Vincoli; witness the Coliseum & Roman Forum (entrance optional); and enjoy the Gesu, the Pantheon, and the Fontana di Trevi.
- July 22<sup>nd</sup> Walk through the **Holy Door** to marvel at St. Peter's, the Vatican Museums and the Sistine Chapel.
- July 23<sup>rd</sup> Explore the Catacombs of San Callisto, St. John Lateran, the Holy Stairs, and Santa Croce. Spend time in St. Mary Major and Santa Prassede.
- July 24<sup>th</sup> Depart for Assisi. Spend the afternoon visiting the Basilicas of St. Francis and St. Claire. See the Portiuncula within St. Mary of the Angels. Depart on an overnight bus to Krakow.
- July 25<sup>th</sup> Arrive in Krakow, check into accommodations, and prepare for WYD.
- July 26<sup>th</sup> Take a walking city tour of Krakow to explore St. Mary's Basilica, the Divine Mercy Shrine, the JP II "Have No Fear:" Shrine and Center, Wawel Cathedral, and Market Square (time permitting). WYD Opening Ceremonies begin this afternoon.
- July 27<sup>th</sup> Morning catechesis, WYD cultural events in the afternoon
- July 28<sup>th</sup> Morning catechesis, Welcoming Ceremonies for our Holy Father
- July 29<sup>th</sup> Morning catechesis, WYD cultural events in the afternoon, and Stations of the Cross with our Holy Father in the evening
- July 30<sup>th</sup> Morning pilgrimage, evening vigil with our Holy Father
- July 31<sup>st</sup> Morning Mass with our Holy Father, pilgrimage back to accommodations
- Aug 1<sup>st</sup> Depart Krakow for Houston
