Camp Director, Jenette Hafernik

Jenette Hafernik graduated from the University of Houston Moores School of Music and the Honors College in 2009 with a Bachelor of Music. During her years at the University of Houston, she earned honors for a thesis examining living North American composers, their compositions, and the trends being currently established in choral music. She also became a professional singer at the Co-Cathedral of the Sacred Heart; a position she continues to hold.

She began her teaching career as the assistant choir director at Clear Springs High School, then head choir director at Clear Lake High School. As a director at both of these schools, she worked with students who made the Texas All-State Choir and received superior ratings in both UIL Concert and Sight Reading and UIL Solo and Ensemble. She is an active member in TMEA and TCDA, and served as TMEA Region 17 treasurer for two years.

From 2012 – 2014, Jenette established a vocal studio of over fifty junior high and high school students from a number of schools in the Houston area. It was a joy to see her students develop musically and vocally in those two years. From 2016 – 2017, Jenette worked for AFA bringing a choral program to Hamilton Middle School.

Currently, she is the music teacher for CCE students at the Co-Cathedral of the Sacred Heart. She teaches the RSCM curriculum to the students who are interested in a music based CCE program. This combines music literacy, music theory, and vocal technique, with the teachings of the Catholic Church and the Sunday liturgy. Her other class is for junior high and high school CCE students. Her focus is to deepen their understanding of the liturgy and to help them reach a fuller relationship with Christ through studying the music sung during Mass. When she is not teaching, she is a wife and mother of two beautiful children who keep her busy.
