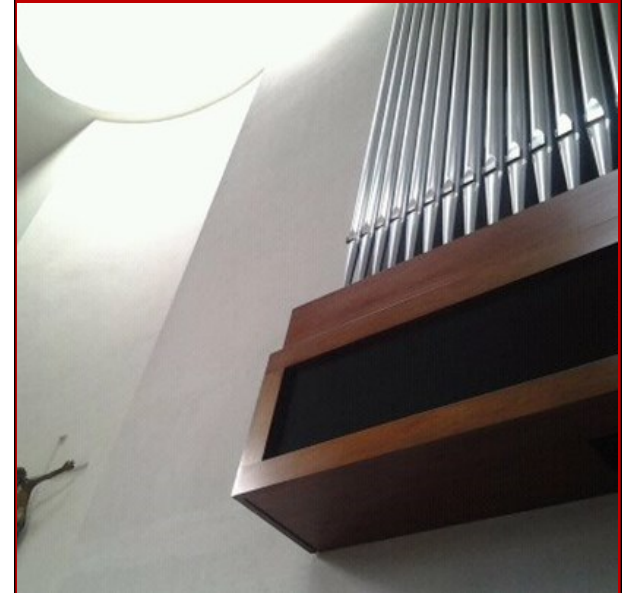

She performs as a solo organist and collaborative keyboardist throughout the greater Houston area and beyond; her 2016-2017 performances include collaborations with UST Singers, Blinn College Choir, Chorus Angelorum, Texas Camerata, Houston Cecilia Chamber Choir, and Houston Choral Society; her solo appearances include the Bayoubüchlein Concert at the AGO 2016 National Convention in Houston, organ recital series at Christ the King Lutheran Church, the Co-Cathedral of the Sacred Heart, St. Theresa Catholic Church, First Evangelical Lutheran Church, and St. Thomas Aquinas Catholic Church in Michigan.
