She performs as a solo organist and collaborative keyboardist throughout the greater Houston area and beyond; her appearances in 2018 include organ/choral events at the Co-Cathedral, the Cathedral of Our Lady of Walsingham, All Saints Catholic's Bravura Series, HBU Organ Recital Series, and UST Summer Organ Camp.
