

Exit Survey 2018 Summary

The 10-question survey sent to UST School of Education and Human Services graduates received 27 responses despite having been sent on three different occasions. Results are similar to previous years in that nearly all responses were “Strongly Agree” or “Agree”. Graduates reported that faculty teaching the courses were effective teachers, were interested in students’ academic experiences and challenges, were accessible to conference with them and that their courses were academically challenging. Only one student indicated that he disagreed about faculty accessibility.

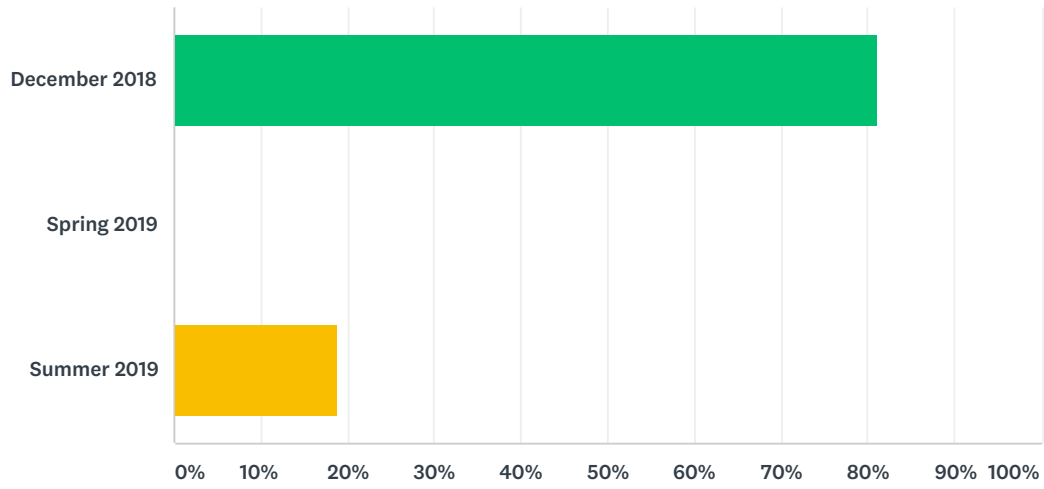
When students were asked to rate their graduate program all but three students responded “Strongly Agree” or “Agree”. Students believed their academic/professional interaction with other student contributed significantly to attaining their educational goals and that their graduate program provided them with opportunities to engage in scholarship, research, and creativity. All but three students believed that their program kept pace with the recent trends and developments in their field and that their graduate program had high academic standards.

Results about Graduate Admissions Office, Graduate Faculty, Library Services, and Technology Services varied more so than the previous areas described above. Eighty-three percent reported Graduate Faculty and Graduate Admissions Office as Superior or Very Good. Graduates were less enthusiastic about Library Services (70% as Superior or Very Good) and Technology Services (62% as Superior or Very Good) .

Overall, graduates indicated that their educational experience at UST met or exceeded their expectations (96% Agree or Strongly Agree). All of the graduates who responded would recommend UST to their family and friends (100% Agree or Strongly Agree).

Q1 Semester and Year of Graduation

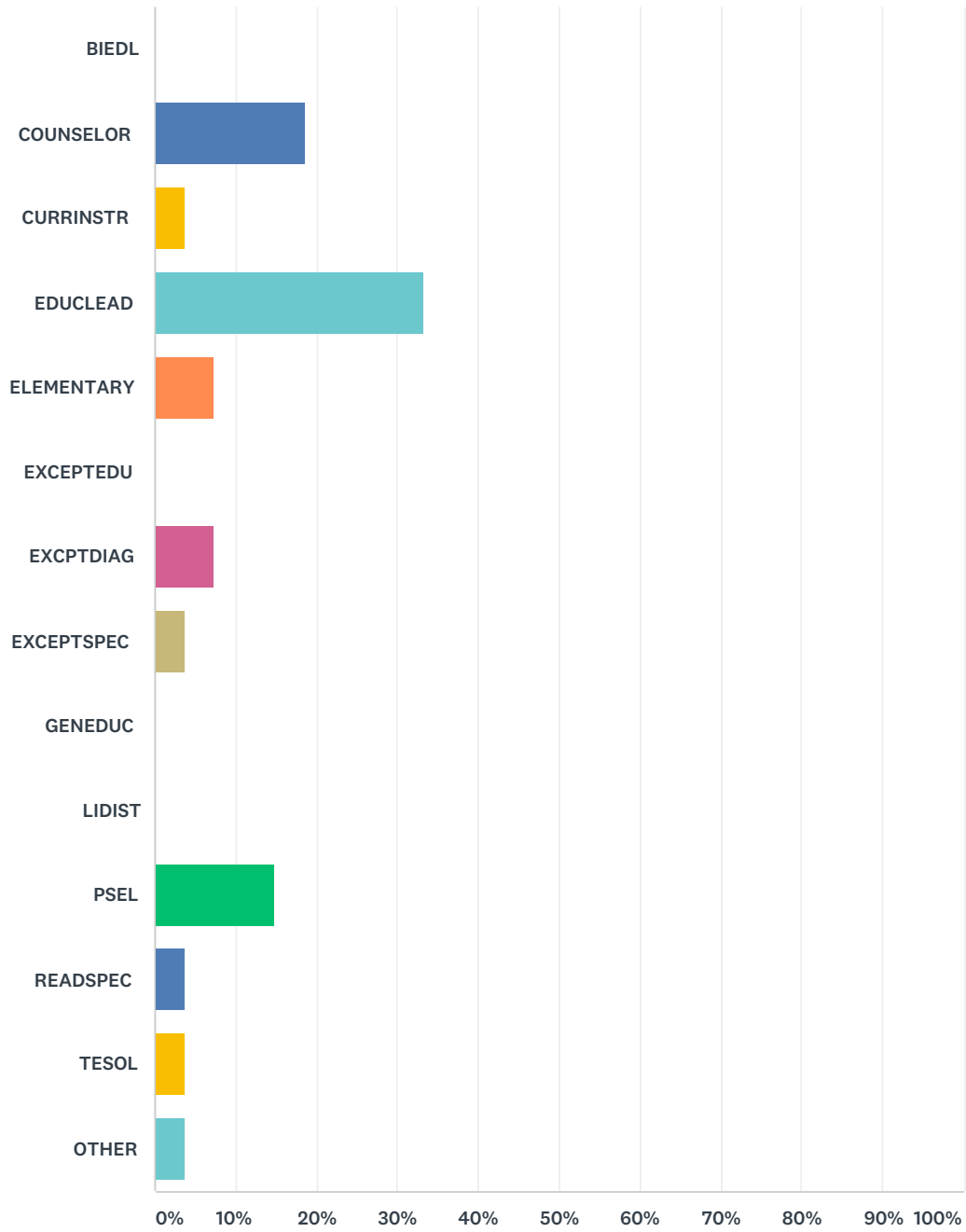

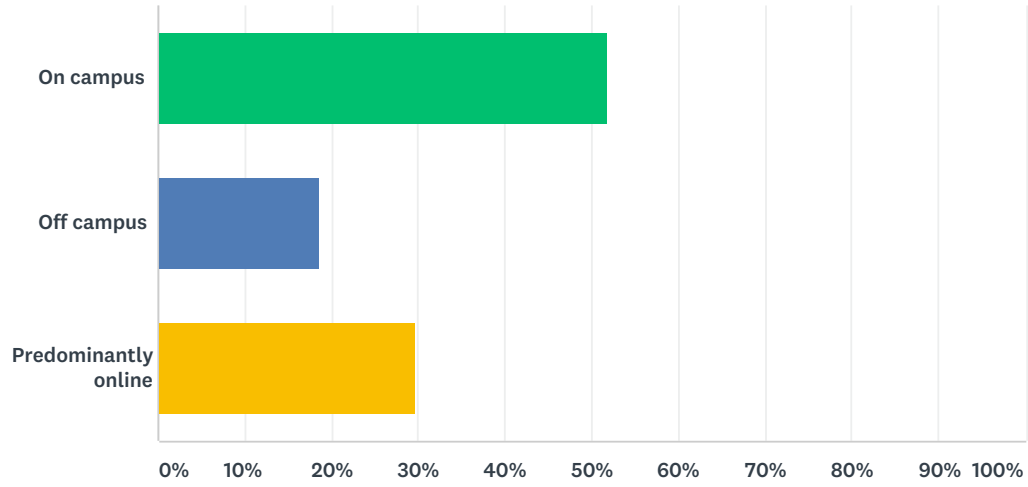

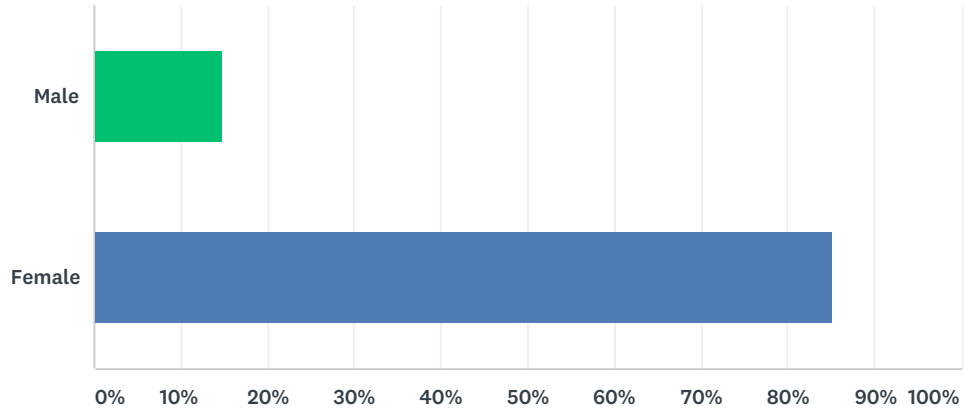

Q4 Gender

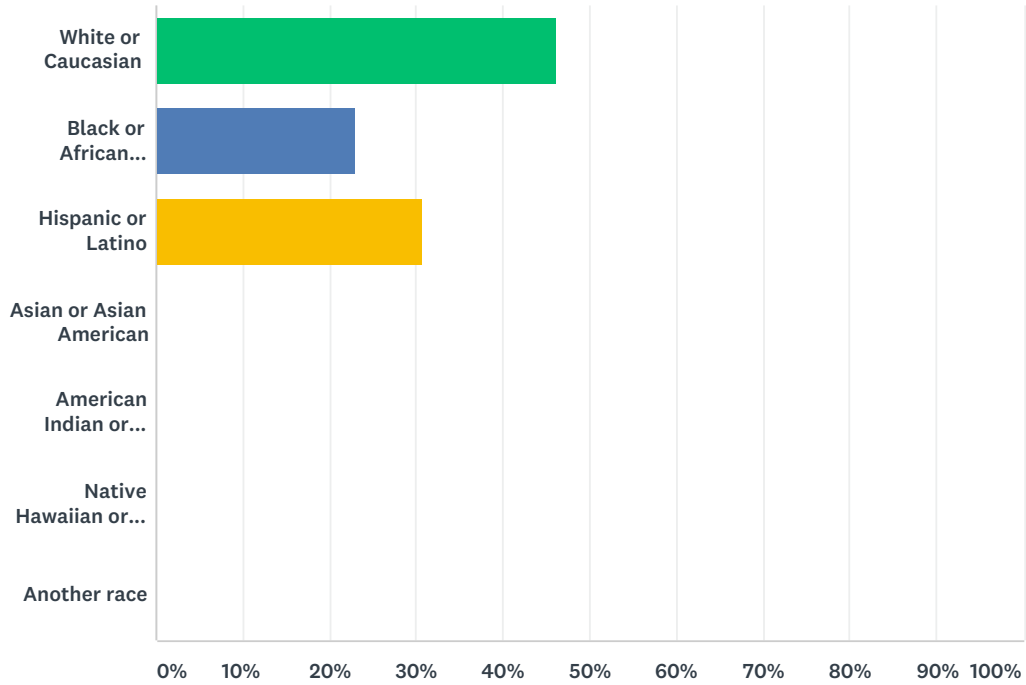

Q5 Ethnicity

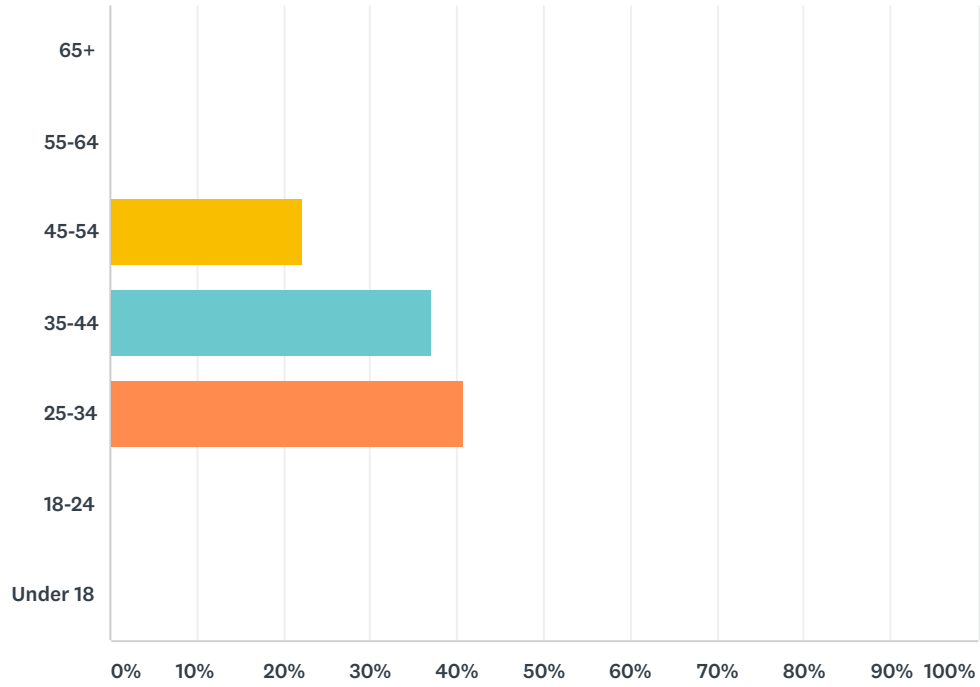

Q6 Age Range

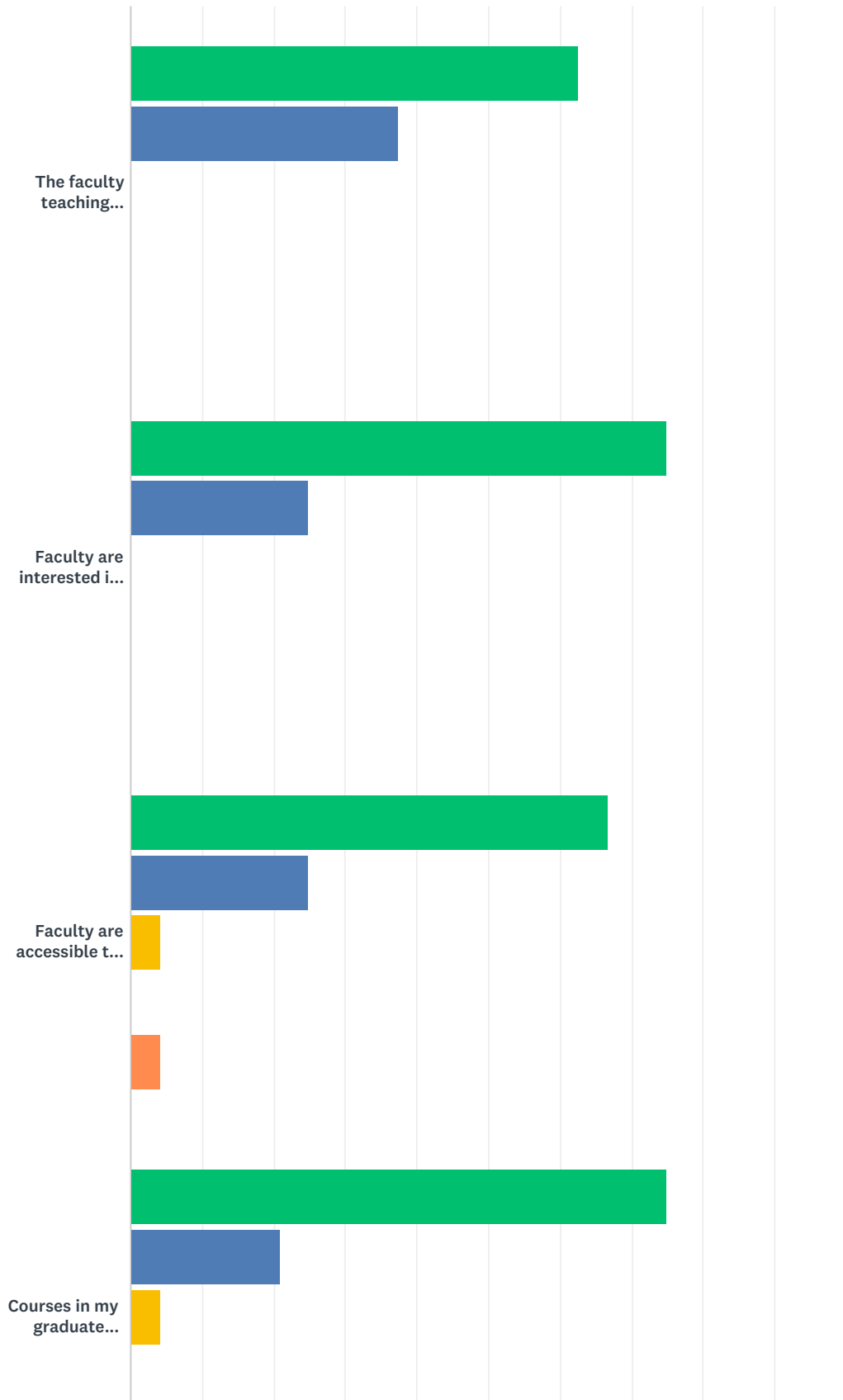

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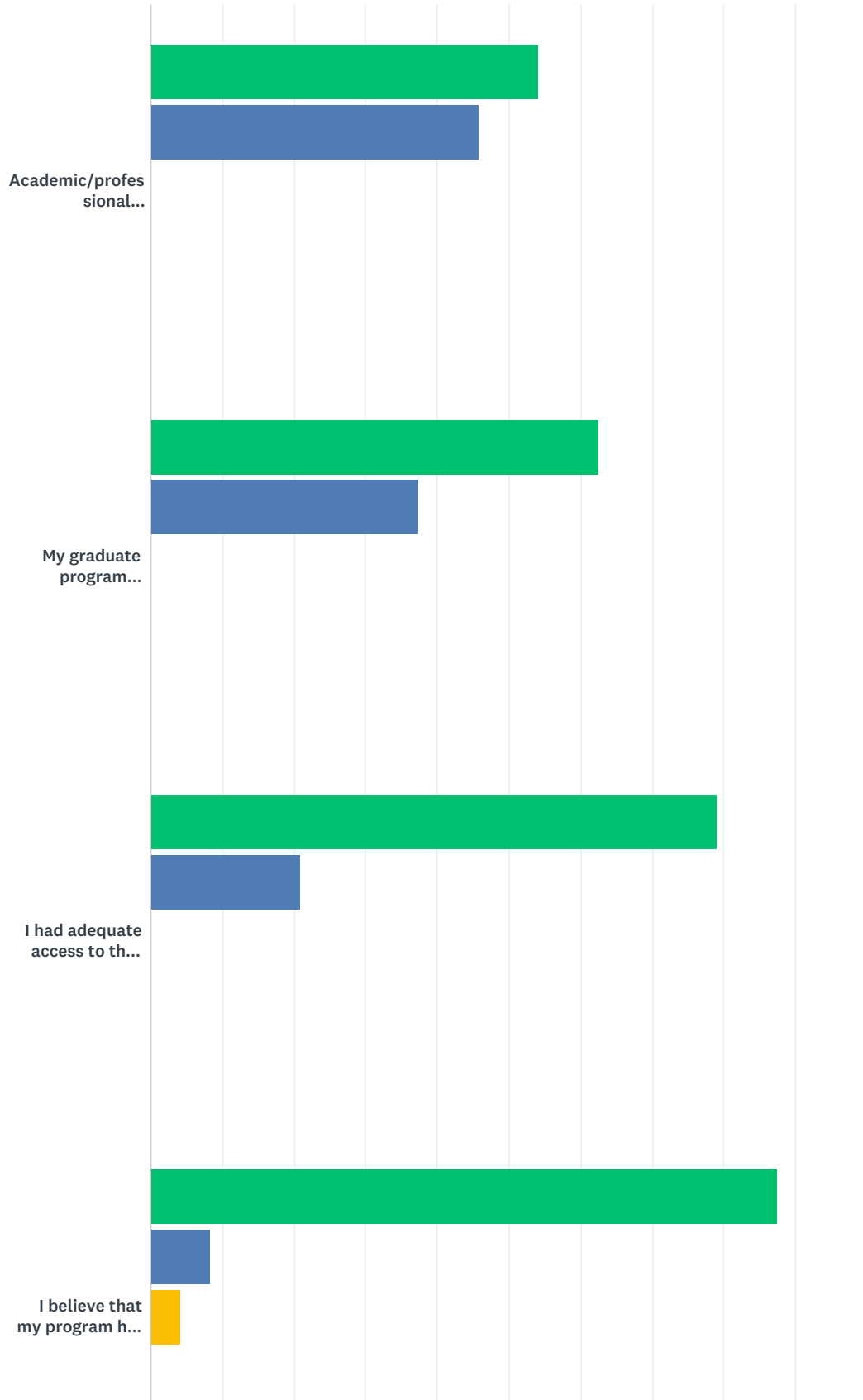

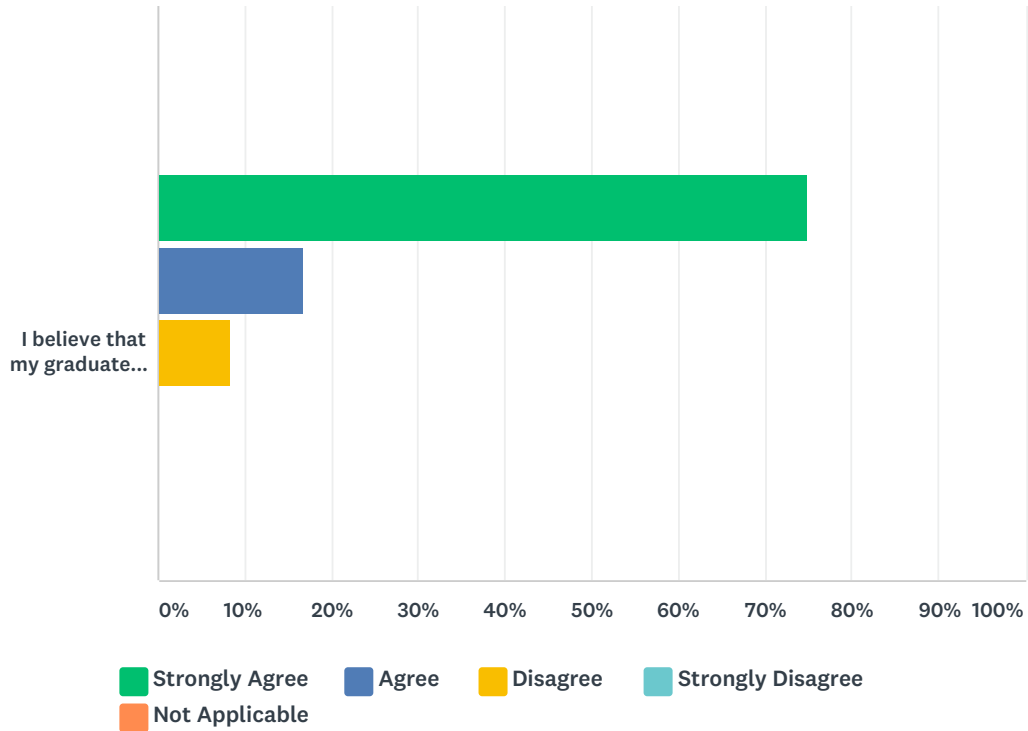
