REQUIREMENTS FOR PRINCIPAL CERTIFICATION:

1. Master's degree
2. Two years of teaching experience as the teacher of record
3. Teacher certificate
4. Principal preparation program (includes minimum of 200 hours of classroom instruction plus 160 hour of practicum experience)
5. Successful completion of TExES #068 (principal certification exam)

TEACHING EXPERIENCE: Minimum two years required for Professional Certificates with a valid Teacher Certificate.

NOTE: Teachers a may take six courses or 18 hours in this degree plan at a 50% tuition scholarship. To receive the scholarship the students must request the Catholic Leadership Scholarship for the specific courses for which the scholarship is requested in writing. The SOE Graduate office will request the tuition adjustment from the business office.
