Frequently Asked Questions – Graduation May 2020 and COVID-19

1. With Commencement rescheduled, will I still graduate in May?

Yes. Degrees for spring graduates will have a conferral date of May 16th, 2020. The conferral date for summer graduates is August 4th, 2020.

2. When do I get confirmation that I've fulfilled all of my requirements and I actually am graduating?

The Registrar's office has up to 30 days after the degree conferral date to verify your degree requirements. After your degree requirements have been verified, you will receive an email from the Office of the Registrar congratulating you on the completion of your degree. Please note that all correspondence is sent to your @stthom.edu email account. Please keep that inbox clear so you can receive messages.

3. When will I receive my diploma?

Diplomas are ordered after degrees are conferred. It takes approximately 4-6 weeks after degree conferral for diplomas to arrive from the printer. Upon arrival, students are notified via email to their @stthom.edu email address that diplomas are ready. At that time, we will assess whether these can be picked up in person or whether they need to be mailed to students.
