Up to \$750 per student per course for the first 10 to register and qualify

- Application: Completion of an application for an Irish Studies scholarship and submission of the completed application to the Director, Center for Irish Studies by email (irishstudies@stthom.edu) or in person (4206 Yoakum Blvd., Building #57)

Submission of an application does not guarantee receipt of a scholarship

Eligible students will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis, to the first 10 students who apply and qualify, until funds dedicated to this course are exhausted

- Eligibility: Enrollment in this Irish Studies course for credit

The student must enroll in the course timely, use the assigned books and materials for preparation and successfully complete all of the requirements of the course; if the student withdraws, never attends or stops attending classes, or does not complete all of the requirements for the course, he or she will forfeit the award

- Satisfactory Academic Progress: Successful completion of the course requirements

The award will be made after the student has successfully completed the course with a grade of B (3.0) or higher

- Use of the Award: To cover tuition for this Irish Studies course (or other tuition, fees or expenses at UST if tuition for this Irish Studies course has been paid)
- One-Time Award: The \$750 scholarship may be awarded only once for each class
- If a student previously was awarded a scholarship from the Center for Irish Studies, but did not successfully complete the course, the student is not eligible for a second scholarship from the Center for Irish Studies
- Additional Information: The Scholarship Committee reserves the right to request additional information from students
