The Master of Education in Educational Leadership with Principal Certification program is designed to provide individuals with an opportunity to acquire knowledge and practical experience for assuming the role of principal and a variety of other administrative positions in the public schools.

CAREER OUTCOMES

Upon completion of the program, students will earn a Master of Education degree in Educational Leadership and be eligible to take the TExES Principal Exam for principal certification in the state of Texas. Principal certification is typically used for all administrative positions, from assistant principal to assistant superintendent in Texas K-12 schools. Students who already hold a UST Master's degree have the option to complete Principal Certification as a second resource area on their transcripts.

Experienced educators with at least two years teaching experience who are interested in becoming an administrator in a K-12 school or district.
