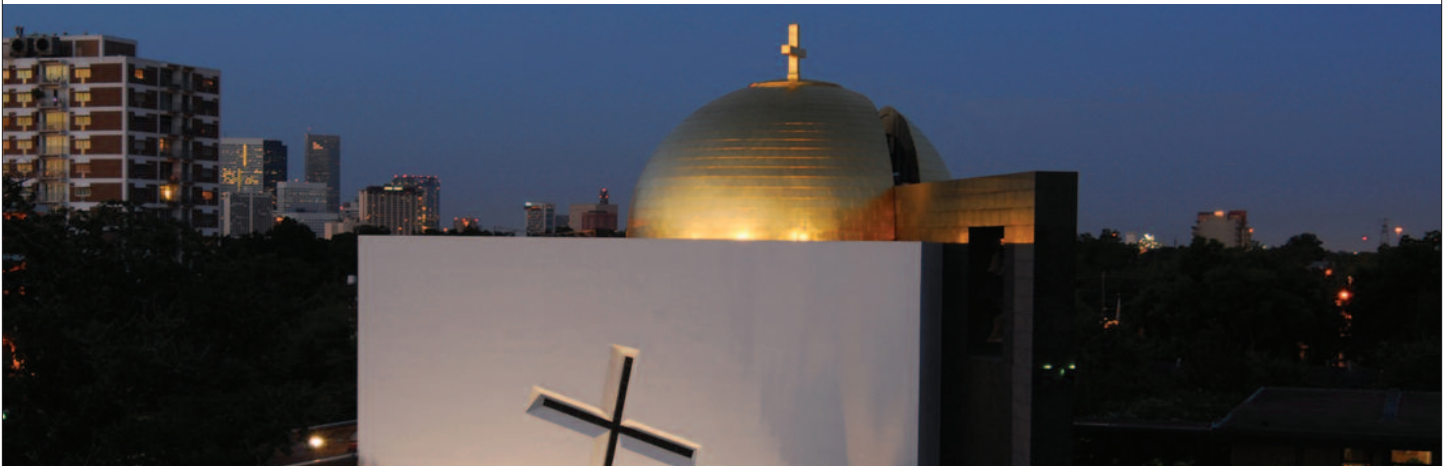

18-CREDIT HOUR JOINT GRADUATE CERTIFICATE: SCHOOL OF EDUCATION / CENTER FOR FAITH AND CULTURE

DESCRIPTION: The Graduate Certificate in Catholic School Leadership is designed for educators, both veteran and new, who wish to enhance their knowledge and understanding of Catholic School leadership with distinctive graduate preparation. The program places distinct emphasis on the integration of faith and the American way of life in all aspects of the school.
