



# JD/MBA JOINT DEGREE PROGRAM

## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

**DESCRIPTION:** UST and the South Texas College of Law Houston established a joint academic program that allows qualified students to earn a Doctor of Jurisprudence (JD) and a Master of Business Administration (MBA) degree in as few as four years. Under the plan, a student attends South Texas College of Law Houston for the first two years, UST's Cameron School of Business for the third year and Houston College of Law for the fourth year.

Students must be admitted to both schools to participate in the program. The joint program is designed to train students to think more strategically and allow them to leverage the strengths of both fields.

**ADMISSION TO THE UNIVERSITY OF ST. THOMAS CAMERON SCHOOL OF BUSINESS GRADUATE PROGRAMS (MBA) REQUIRES THAT STUDENTS MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:**

- Students may apply to UST only after their formal acceptance to South Texas College of Law Houston.
- Students must possess a bachelor's degree from an accredited institution in any field of study.
- Admission is based on a combination of Law School Admission Test (LSAT) score and undergraduate grade point average (GPA).
- Students must complete sixty (60) credit hours earned at South Texas College of Law Houston before taking core MBA courses at UST.

**APPLICATION MATERIALS TO UST MUST INCLUDE:**

- Online application and \$35 application fee
- Three letters of recommendation from professional or academic sources
- Official transcript(s) from all postsecondary schools attended
- Official LSAT at a level acceptable for South Texas College of Law Houston admission
- South Texas College of Law Houston transcript, including cumulative GPA.
